

WIOA Title I Adult Employment & Training Activities

The President's budget proposes \$490,370,000 for WIOA Title I Adult, a 40% cut to the program from current funding levels. Below is an estimate of how much WIOA Title I Adult funding each state will lose under the President's proposal.¹
